1. Meeting Wrap-up

- We had alternating activity and business meetings this term
- Suggestion: call them "activities", so people don't get confused between business and activity meetings
- Should have more consistent notice like mailings to tell people and keep track
- Format: good setup, good to have meetings after shows for show wrap-ups
- Meetings should be faster
- Good activities, people who showed up had fun

2. Show Wrap-up

- Request/suggestion: longer dinner break, more time to get food from outside, we can do that, now we have Saturdays
- Format: we had 3 consecutive series, 1 of them finished (Ouran); 3 samplers total, 2 movies
 - From survey: mostly positive of format, want samplers moved to start of show, or to Saturdays
- Was pretty good at starting on time, one show was 20 min late due to AV room door being jammed. Had all the disks
- Jeopardy ran a little longer than expected
- Best-Of Show didn't turn out as well as we wanted; didn't integrate with Warrior Weekends as well as we thought due to miscommunication of what we wanted and what they wanted

3. Event Wrap-up

- Art/AMV contest –wished has more submissions but was well-received, the setup of using projector was good; gave out main prizes
- Jeopardy went really well, participants (5 teams of 2) had lots of fun; need to allocate more time; add video/audio clues; less Daily Double clues; good depth (not too easy or too hard) and variety of clues

- Caption contest good submissions (which are uploaded to club gallery); good event to have, anyone can participate
- Name that Tune a bit too difficult, due to many genres (try to target everyone);
 maybe collaborate, or have songs from series show recently by the club
- Story Contest about 5 submissions; maybe use microphone to read out loud, couldn't hear some of the entries
- Sushi Lunch went well, 9 people showed up, and was fun; maybe have 2 per term; have it earlier in the term to attract new members
- Karaoke –success, had 10 people; good setup with projector and laptop and sound system; book it in AL next time, don't have to move equipment; maybe have it earlier next term
- Laser Quest didn't go as well as expected; only Watsfic and Watsoc showed up; had enough people to earn back the money paid that day, but didn't make back deposit from 3 terms ago; in future, don't book, just show up, allows flexibility and only costs \$2 more per person

4. Show Format Announcement

- Starting next term, the execs are talking over Saturday shows and concessions. The execs requested to talk to Adam, but he didn't show up or reply. Instead, he cancelled Yester-Term shows for the rest of the term.
 - Adam announced the cancellation of Yester-Term on his website, without telling us, which caused confusion for members because the execs haven't had a chance to tell members yet (since Adam hadn't replied)
